I heard from our very own Kathy Bryson, who serves the PNW Conference of the United Methodist Church as our Early Response Coordinator. Kennewick First was a drop off point for a truck carrying two pallets of "Flood Buckets" from the United Methodist Committee on Relief Depot in Salt Lake City to help with clean up after flooding in Walla Walla County. Dave Hare and Bob Kelly took our Church trailer down to Walla Walla Thursday afternoon and delivered the buckets. (THANK YOU, DAVE AND BOB!) Kathy notified me that the American Red Cross (ARC) is setting up a "Multi Agency Response Center" (or MARC) at the Walla Walla Fairgrounds pavilion this Friday, Saturday and Sunday (Feb 14, 15, 16) from 10 am - 5pm. ARC case workers will be onsite as well as volunteer organizations providing information and resources for recent flood survivors. The PNW UMC Disaster Response has been invited to participate and distribute the UMCOR "Cleaning Kits" that arrived at KFUMC this morning. ARC anticipates 100-200 people will attend though they admitted the numbers could be lower.

We are looking for UMC volunteers to staff our table. I've done this before and know that most coming to the MARC will be in some stage of trauma. Volunteers with experience, as Stephens Ministers, medical professionals, or have worked in first response, disaster response and/or relief professions would be the best fit.
