Remember, we have very strict guidelines regarding how many we can place in our parking spots, and in the grass with social distancing, so when the spots are full we cannot let anymore in, and you will have to park on the street or somewhere off property. If you are showing symptoms of illness or getting out in public has put you at specific risks, please use your best judgment when deciding whether to sign up or not. The parking lot will open at 10 am and we are asking that you enter from the Everett Street side (West end) and we will exit out the Dayton Street side (East end) when worship is over.
