Remember, we have very strict guidelines regarding how many cars we can put in our parking spots with social distancing, so when the spots are full we cannot let anymore in, and you will have to park on the street or somewhere off property. If you are showing symptoms of illness or getting out in public puts you at specific risks, please use your best judgment when deciding whether to sign up or not. The parking lot will open at 10 am and we are asking that you enter from the 1st Avenue side of the parking lot. If you cannot be there in person, remember we are live streaming the service on our YouTube channel.
