# <u>A quick reminder...</u>

As our community moves through the latest spike in a worldwide pandemic, we want to remind us of all of the protocols we have in place for gathering in person inside our church facilities. 7) *Temporarily* suspend congregational singing during worship services.

8) Encourage everyone to stay home if you are feeling sick, have a fever or are showing symptoms of the virus or have been in close contact with someone who has the virus.
