Hi friends,

I had the pleasure of meeting with Julio Blanco, the Principal of Amistad Elementary School. An elementary School just a stone's throw away from our Church building. Amistad is a unique Elementary School with a large enrolment (nearly 700 students) that has many challenges. Bob Kelly and I met with Principal Blanco to listen to the needs his school has and to see if there is any way we can be of help to the students there. In the weeks ahead we will be asking you, if you can be a part of some programs that can help the school and its students thrive. In the midst of our conversation, Bob asked if the backpacks and school supplies that our church gathers together at the beginning of the school year are still something that the school needs, to which Principal Blanco replied "yes, they are a huge help." In a side comment, he said what the school needs right now is reams of copy paper. Many teachers are supplementing curriculum with other activities, and they are making lots of copies for their students, and because the enrollment is so high there is a need for copy paper. Helping Amistad with paper is a simple way we can, be not only a good neighbor with the school but, in a real and tangible way helps teachers and students. **So here is my ask of you all**: <u>Would you be willing to buy a few packages of 8.5 X 11, 20lb copy</u> <u>paper and bring it to the church over the next month, that we can give to</u> <u>Amistad as a gift to help the teachers and students there?</u>

I did some simple research, a 500-sheet package of paper usually costs less than \$10. (If you are a good shopper, you can find it for less ... Office Depot on Canal Drive has them half price at the moment) If you are out and about, would you be willing to pick up a package or two and bring them to the church? We will deliver them to the school as a way of being a good neighbor. What a wonderful gift to share with our neighborhood school as a way of saying we care! **Beginning this Sunday, we will begin collecting the packages in the narthex**.

Thank you for considering this proposition and being the kind of church that makes a difference in the neighborhood and city we are a part of!
