<u>A few words about Communion this Sunday at</u> <u>worship</u>

Whether you join us in person or online, we want to encourage you to join us as we share in celebrating and worshipping together. This week is the first Sunday of the month so we will be serving communion. If you participate in our worship service via the online stream, make sure to have bread and juice available.

For the last several months we have been receiving communion in individual cups and precut pieces of bread. This Sunday we will be returning to the "intinction" method, meaning... as you come forward you will receive a piece of bread from the loaf and dip it into a chalice. As always, we will have gluten-free bread available if you need it. If you are uncomfortable sharing communion from a common loaf and chalice, we will have pre-sealed communion cups and wafers available, if that makes it easier for you to receive the elements. If walking to the front of the Sanctuary to receive the elements is difficult, please let us know. Pastor Mark and Jennifer are happy to serve you the elements at your seat. It is a firm belief of our congregation that "the table" is open to anyone wanting to come and receive communion, and we want to make that as easy and safe as possible for all to come!
