is on the way (sometimes even the daffodils and tulips think so too) only to be hit with another bracing cold snap... I fall for it every year! The other thing I can count on is around Christmas and Easter I will be getting phone calls asking "Did you just send me and email (or text messages) asking me to purchase gift cards for someone in need?"

Now that Palm Sunday, Holy Week and Easter are fast approaching we have seen a round of emails being sent out to people claiming to be Pastor Mark, and even from a fake email address that looks similar to our official church email domains. The message states something like... Pastor Mark needs your help immediately and can you reply to the email, because he can't talk on the phone because he is in a meeting. If you reply to the email you get another response asking if you would be able to go buy some gift cards for someone in need and that you will be reimbursed for them later, and then asked to give the #'s and codes to the scammer from the cards. If you get such an email or text message don't reply to it and most importantly don't buy any gift cards and/or give the PIN or information from them to the person in the email. NO ONE FROM THE CHURCH WILL EVER MAKE SUCH A REQUEST THROUGH AN EMAIL OR TEXT AND WE WILL NEVER ASK FOR YOUR PIN NUMBERS OR **PERSONAL INFORMATION IN SUCH A WAY.** There may be times that we invite the congregation to help with special projects, but they will never be done in a confidential manner or in a way that circumnavigates the official financial safeguards our church has in place. If you ever get a message from someone claiming to be connected to Kennewick First (or any organization you belong to for that matter) asking for a confidential donation or asking for personal information, please don't respond to it. Or if you get a message from someone claiming to be staff at the church that just seems odd or out of character, please call the church office and verify that it's not a scam.

It is frustrating that there are people who put such effort into taking advantage of folks like the wonderful members of Kennewick First who work so hard to be generous, compassionate and caring, but it reminds me that the work we do is important to fulfill our baptism vows to proclaim Jesus is the one that saves us, to surround one

another in grace and forgiveness and stand against evil and injustice however it presents itself in the world.
