- 1. Be Kind to everyone that participates in a youth activity and bring any issues straight to a leader.
- 2. Respect for everyone attending youth activities, show God's love through your actions.
- 3. No illegal activities, substances, or weapons of any sort.
- 4. Refrain from foul language, gossip, and inappropriate comedy.
- 5. Keep your phones on silent and put away while in the Youth Chapel, during activities, and whenever it takes away from having a positive UMY experience for you or others.
- 6. No see-through clothing, no under garments showing, and keep your clothing practical.
- 7. Stay in the area you're supposed to be in, always abiding by the rule of three. Students and leaders should always be in an open area with at least two other people present.
- 8. Report any issues or concerns, whether they are physical, mental, emotional, or personal.
- 9. Respect the facility or area that you are in, which may be outside.
- 10. Report any injury to a leader immediately! (We want to help but can't if we don't know.)

Everyone who participates in UMY must agree to abide by these rules. If you choose to break these rules, a youth leader will talk with you and you will be asked to change that behavior. Depending on the seriousness of the breaking of a rule, a team of leaders may meet to discuss the issue to decide if any disciplinary action is still needed and what it would be. If conduct codes are broken while out of town and are serious enough for the youth to be sent home, the parents or guardians are responsible for the transportation.
